Seniors Doubles knockout Rules

Senior members should only put their name down if they play regularly & will commit to playing by the dates on the draw sheets.

All players are responsible for getting the match played on time.

The top pair should offer the bottom pair 3 dates to play the match.

If the bottom pair cannot play on dates offered, the top pair will go through.

If no result is forthcoming by the deadline date, the bottom pair will be put through.

If a player does not play their match by the date specified (due to injury or illness, not holiday), then the date will be extended by a maximum of 2 weeks. If they can still not play, then the other player will be put through.

If someone has to withdraw, the remaining player must play the doubles match on their own this is in the 1st or 2nd round, in which case they may be substituted with someone of a similar handicap who has not played in the doubles or the 1st or 2nd round.

All matches **MUST** be completed by the due dates.
