

## **Rosedale Rules for Men's Knockout Competitions**

**All singles matches to be played off  $\frac{3}{4}$  handicap difference.**

**All doubles matches to be played off  $\frac{3}{4}$  handicap difference.**

**Both, players or pairs, have a responsibility to have the match played by the closing date.**

**Matches can be played on away days providing this does not go beyond the closing date on the draw sheet.**

**The “top” player should contact their opponent immediately the draw is known.**

**The “top” player should offer their opponent three weekend dates. The dates must include either one Saturday or Sunday. (3 Sundays or 3 Saturdays is not acceptable unless mutually agreed)**

**If the bottom player cannot agree to any of the three dates offered and an agreement cannot be made when to play the match then the “top” player will be put through.**

**If the “bottom” player has not been contacted they should try to make contact with the “top” player to get the match played.**

**If the match has not been played by the closing date the “bottom” player will be put through.**

**Extensions to any competitions will only be granted if exceptional weather or course conditions prevail. In the event of a player being injured or having a health issue an application for an extension of a match can be made to the competition officer.**
